

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



Student Clubs



Undergraduate Admissions

International students from all over the world can apply to become a student at İstanbul Bilgi University with their high school graduation certificates or internationally recognized exam results such as SAT, ACT, GCE A LEVEL, Abitur, Matura, Tawjihi, etc.

More information is available for prospective students at the International Student Admissions Office.

Prospective international students should submit their application as follows:

- 1. The student should fill in the international student Application Form
- 2. The student should forward scanned copies of the following required documents to the attention of the International Student Admissions Office

The required documents for undergraduate applications are:

- Photocopy of high school diploma (with the official transcript Apostilled)
- All high school transcripts/grades (corresponding to the 3 or 4 high school years Apostilled)
- Copy of passport
- 2 photographs
- If available, a record of scores for one English Language Proficiency Examination (for example TOEFL or Cambridge Certificate)

NOTE:

International students applying with their SAT exam score should send their score officially by using our Designated Institution (DI) code: 7293 - İstanbul Bilgi University.

Graduate Admissions

Online Application

To become a graduate student in BiLGİ, you should first fill in the online application form. Once you complete online application, application requirements, necessary documents and details about assessment process are sent to your e-mail.

Application Requirements

Each program has its own application requirements. You can learn the application requirements from the programs' websites. If you don't have a valid English language proficiency certificate, you can enter BİLGİ Graduate Online English Exam (BİLET 3) to determine your proficiency level. Only TOEFL and BİLET3 exam score is accepted as an English Profiency exam for foreign students.

BİLET3 ise free of charge and candidates takes the exam via Zoom.

Assessment

If you are deemed suitable after your online application, you are invited to an interview and/or written exam for further assessment. Interviews can take place via Zoom.

Acceptance and Registration

Once a candidate is accepted to a graduate program, s/he receives a pre-registration link and an e-mail about the registration documents that should be submitted. When candidate completes the registration procedures before the deadline, s/he receives student status.

English Proficiency Requirement

The medium of instruction at İstanbul Bilgi University is English, therefore the students' English proficiency will be evaluated as follows:

If the prospective international student has obtained a sufficient score from one of the following English Language Proficiency Examinations, then the student will be exempt from the **'English Preparatory Program'** for one academic year at **istanbul Bilgi University:**

- TOEFL IBT

Minimum Score 75

- First Certificate in English (FCE)

Minimum Score B

- Cambridge Certificate in Advanced English (CAE)

Minimum Score C

- Cambridge Proficiency

Minimum Score C

- PTE Academic

Minimum Score 60

NOTE:

-International students should forward their TOEFL report score using our Designated Institution (DI) code: 8256 - İstanbul Bilgi University, as detailed in the TOEFL IBT Information and Registration Bulletin. -If the prospective international student did not obtain a sufficient score from one of the English Language Proficiency Examinations, s/he should take İstanbul Bilgi University Institutional Exemption Test (BİLET) upon arrival/registration.

-Those who fail the Institutional Exemption Test must register to the English Preparatory Program at İstanbul Bilgi University before beginning their academic studies. This preparatory year is not included in the total number of years of study required for graduation.

English Preparatory Program

Since most of the programs at istanbul Bilgi University are offered in English, students should have a good command of English in order to follow the courses. If desired, students can study the entire or a portion of their English preparatory education at the language programs of contracted universities in the US.

English Preparatory Program has CEA accreditation (Commission on English Language Program Accreditation), one of the most comprehensive accreditations in the field of English language education.

CEA Accreditation has 44 quality standards covering many criteria ranging from curriculum to student services and from program structure to program improvement. This accreditation allows certification of education quality while it also ensures that the quality is continuously improved and is sustained.




